Bus from Stoke on Trent station (9, 21, 23, 24, 25) to Hanley bus station (walking alternative is approx 20-25 mins). Walk from bus station via Bagnall Street, Pall Mall to Piccadilly (4 mins).

Continue on Piccadilly, R on Stafford Street, L on Percy Street/Parliament Row, L on Old Hall Street (about 5 mins).

Woodman 3 Goodson Street ST1 2AT

Return to Parliament Row, turn N and continue through Market Square to Town Road. Continue across roundabout and A50. L at park (Union Street) (about 10 mins).

Bulls Head 139 Lower Bryan Street ST1 5AT

Return on Union Street and L at roundabout onto Town Road, then R on Old Town Road (5 mins).

• Golden Cup 65 Old Town Road ST1 2JS

L on Broom Street, R at end (6 mins).

Cat Inn 81 Keelings Road ST1 6PA

Cont on Keelings Road (1 min)

Wheatsheaf Stores 78 Keelings Road ST1 6PB

Cont on Keelings Road, L onto Janet's Place (5 min)

Northwood Inn 55 Botany Bay Road ST1 6PU

Cont on Botany Bay Road, L on Perceval Street, L on Birch Street, R on Vincent Street (5 mins)

• Cross Guns 19 Vincent Street ST1 6PW

Cont on Vincent Street, L at end, 2nd R (Rose Street), L on Oak Street/Harrop Street to end (12 mins).

Birches Head 119-121 Birches Head Road ST1 6LL

Turn R on leaving pub, then 1st R (Barthomley Street) and L on Acton Street to end (3 mins).

Cheshire Cheese 48 Chell Street ST1 6BA

Bus 7, 7A, 8, or 9 to bus station. Cross main road to pub. (Or walk 20 mins.)

Coachmakers Arms 65 Lichfield Street ST1 3EA

Return to bus station for bus 9, 21, 23, 24, 25 to railway station.

Total walking distance (assuming bus taken from railway station to Hanley bus station and return, plus from Cheshire Cheese to bus station) about 3 miles.

(The five pubs marked with a bullet are Camra heritage pubs - except The Woodman which has won a restoration award.)
