## Derbyshire pub crawl by public transport

## Saturday, 9th June 2018

This crawl takes place entirely within Derbyshire and the full cost of all buses and trains will be covered by the purchase of a Derbyshire Wayfarer ticket (which includes the portion of the train journey between Sheffield and Derbyshire). Meet at **Sheffield Tap** on the station from 10am.

(10:00 - 10:25)

Trains to Derby at 10:24 or 10:29 arrive at 10:51 or 10:59.

Walk to **Brunswick Inn** 1 Railway Terrace **DE1 2RU** which opens at 11am. (11:05 – 11:45)

Train to Duffield at **11:52**, arrive 11:59. Walk into Duffield, turning L on A6 to **Town Street Tap** (micropub) 17 Town Street **DE56 4EH** . (**12:05 – 13:00**)

Alternatives are Pattenmakers Arms and White Hart.

Bus to Milford (takes about four mins): TP or any one of the Sixes from the stops just S of White Hart or N of the micro. 13:03 (TransPeak), **13:06** (6.1), 13:21 (6.2) or 13:36 (6.4). Get off at the stop after the bridge and walk back to <u>King William</u> or, for a real treat, continue past the pub and walk to Makeney (about 10 mins from bus stop, mostly uphill): <u>Holly Bush Inn</u> Holly Bush Lane **DE56 0RX** (13:20 – 14:15)

(Alternative route for keen walkers: Walk S through Duffield then left on Makeney Lane, across the river near the Bridge Inn then L to Makeney. About 35 mins.)

Return to bus stop past the bridge for bus to Belper bus station (about 10 mins) at **14:25** (6.2), 14:40 (6.4) or 14:55 (6.3). **Belper walkabout** from **14:40 to 16:05**, which could include <u>George & Dragon</u>, <u>Arkwright's Real Ale Bar</u> and <u>Angels Micropub</u>.

Bus 138 at **16:10** from stop B on King Street (just around the corner from Arkwrights) or a minute later from the Market Place stop (a short walk from Angels). **DO NOT MISS THIS BUS!** 

The bus terminates at Breach Road in Marlpool. The <u>Queens Head</u> is on the corner, and right next to it is the <u>Marlpool Alehouse</u> 5 Breach Road **DE75 7NJ**. The alehouse is quite small, so if it's too busy to get to the bar, the Queens Head is an acceptable alternative.

(**16:50 – 17:40** or 18:10)

Return to bus stop for bus 21 at **17:43** or 18:17 to Ilkeston, South Street (Health Centre), arriving about 15 minutes later. Walk back past the Prince of Wales and turn right on Gladstone St to the **Burnt Pig** 53 Market Street **DE7 5RB**. (**18:00** or 18:35 **– 19:10** or 19:40)

To get to the station by bus, aim for the 27 at **19:14** from the stop on South Street on the other side of the road. There are also buses at 19:22 and 19:42 (Y3 from same stop) but they only go to the other end of town and it is then a 15 min walk, so keen walkers may want to give the buses a miss on this occasion: it's about 25 minutes. (Market St, R on Hallcroft Road, across the by pass, through the park, past the school, keep straight ahead until Station Rd, turn R.) Trains are at 19:29 (which the 27 bus should meet) or at **20:29** and 21:29. If going for the later train(s) there will be time for a beer or two at the **Dewdrop Inn** 24 Station Street **DE7 5TE**. (**19:25 – 20:25**)

Trains take about 40 to 45 mins and arrive in Sheffield at about quarter past the hour.
